

PLANNING BOARD MINUTES
NOVEMBER 19, 2018

A regular meeting of the Town of Dickinson Planning Board was held on the 19th day of November, 2018, in the Town Meeting Room, Town Office Building, 531 Old Front Street, Binghamton, New York. Chairman Wasser called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

The Board held a brief discussion concerning a possible project at Elizabeth Church Manor. The project is in the early planning stages and the board will be kept up to date if further information is made available to the Town. The Board stated that any project should include proper ingress and egress from the site and screening along the side property line.

The Board continued their discussion on becoming an age friendly community. The board will continue to hold discussions with the hope of including a small section in the Comprehensive Plan. The Broome County Office of the Aging will be sending out a survey in the near future.

Supervisor Marinaccio stated that he has been in contact with the new owner of the Starbuck's property. He is currently reviewing different options for the other spaces in the building.
