

JANUARY 4, 2010 – WORK SESSION

The Work Session of the Town Board of the Town of Dickinson was called to order by Supervisor Michael A. Marinaccio on Monday, January 4, 2010 at 5:30 PM in the Town Hall, 531 Old Front St., Binghamton, NY.

Supervisor Marinaccio gave the floor to Judge Greg Gates who was present to give an overview as to the case load in Town Court and some of the security measures that should be put in place. A report is on file in the Town Clerk's office. Clerk Jill Bodie will give a list of security measures to the Town Board.

ATTORNEY

Mr. Blaise reported he is checking into the hold up of demolition of 213 Bevier St. He also stated he received a quit claim deed from the attorney for the church which he is having one of his Real Estate partners look over. He stated the church must still get permission from the Court before they can turn the property over to the Town, but the back taxes have been paid.

Mr. Blaise is in receipt of the Town of Fenton contract regarding the Dog Control Officer which is for 1 year and is basically the same as 2009. A resolution will be passed at the Regular Meeting to accept this contract.

Mr. Blaise explained the Town has an overdue account for burial in Glenwood Cemetery from Pucedo Funeral Home in the amount of \$450.00. A certified letter sent by Attorney Blaise was received and signed for.

CHAIR

Supervisor Marinaccio went over his recommended appointments for 2010 and also the meeting dates and holidays. The question was asked if Ron Lake could serve as deputy constable since he has had all the schooling. Attorney Blaise will look into this.

Mr. Marinaccio reported receipt of a letter from Marchuska stating there is a dentist interested in property on Glenwood Rd. which is zoned R-1.

PUBLIC WORKS

There will be a meeting on March 3, 2010 at 9:00 AM to go over all sewer discharge in the Town of Dickinson with EPA.

Commissioner Kie and Deputy Commissioner Miller explained the need to replace the water main on Pulaski St. Approximately 1600 feet at an approximate cost of \$200,000. At present the existing main is only 4". This street will also need new storm sewers as Mr. Kie has run a camera into the present ones which are falling apart. A discussion was held on sewer line replacement which Mr. Miller stated is not needed.

The question was asked if the water agreement with the Town of Chenango is in place? Attorney Blaise stated it is. Mr. Kie stated the Town received no e-mail on the last 5 day shut off. According to the contract written notification is to be given.

Mr. Mill reported receipt of \$75,874.91 from Broome Developmental Center in payment for the muffin monster job on Glenwood Rd. He stated Achieve, on Cutler Pond Rd. would like to hook 3 laterals in to the sewer on Ferndale Dr. A discussion followed on possible charges. Engineer Ron Lake and Attorney Blaise will look into this matter and report.
