## DID YOU KNOW?

That in 1936 several Sunrise Terrace women formed a Garden Club, and in 1940 the Sunrise Terrace Association was formed.

That in 1946 Francis J. Boland generously deeded the tract of land adjoining the entrance of the Terrace to the Town of Dickinson for widening the Terrace entrance and for park purposes.

That on January 2, 1952 seven residents, acting as a representative committee of the informal Sunrise Terrace Association, incorporated the Association. The Certificate of Incorporation included the statement:

"The purpose of the Association shall be to protect and to promote the best interests of the residents of Sunrise Terrace with the aim of always maintaining Sunrise Terrace as a desirable and friendly residential community."

That in 1956 the Board of Directors broke ground for the "Recreation Hall" to be built on the former Boland land. Members were Bob Charles, Barney Creager, Joe Gaube, Joe Gilan, Walt Hanan, Fritz Koerbel, Doug Lawson, Joe Neschleba, Harold Strader, and Bill Bowers.

That more than \$6500 from residential pledges was raised in 1956 so that the Center could be constructed. And that the tables, chairs, dishes and silverware were furnished by the Garden Club.
