Bids for the **Brandywine Heights Water Line Project** were submitted to the Town Clerk on Monday, February 10, 2020. The bids were opened at the February 10, 2020 Town Board meeting.

Public Works Commissioner Kie stated that he and Town Engineer Ron Lake reviewed the bids line by line and recommend that the project be awarded to the low bidder – **CORE&MAIN** in the amount of \$144,805.50.

The order of bid received is as follows:

CORE&MAIN	\$144,805.50
F.W. WEBB COMPANY	\$147,316.56
Blair Supply Corp.	(not considered due to bid being received after the deadline)

On a motion by Councilman Morabito seconded by Councilman Exley to approve the bid award for the Brandywine Heights Water Line Project, also known as the Old State Road Area Water Main Replacement Project to **CORE&MAIN** in the amount of \$144,805.50.
